The Machine Readable Cashier Terminal



The Machine Readable Cashier Terminal combines the proven advantage of an on-line revenue control system with the most advanced automated ticket reading technology.

Uniquely designed for speed, accuracy and long lasting service, this stainless steel terminal uses easy-to-use validation keys, and a preprinted bar code number system to rapidly calculate money owed. Cashier reports are printed and stored at the central server and provide a detailed audit trail of all transaction history. The cashiers' shift reports can include cash collection information or a 'blind' shift report concealing the amount of funds to be turned in.

The machine readable system assigns a random six digit number to each bar-coded ticket for robust backup just in case a bar code can not be read. An outstanding ticket report is generated to reveal all tickets that have not yet been processed out of the system, enabling auditors to determine absolute accountability and ensure no loss of revenue.

Validations can be "electronically" attached to a ticket to avoid theft or mis-use. Rates for all devices are calculated at the central server, using one central clock for extreme accuracy. Credit card processing is integrated into the system. Transactions from all exit lanes and central payment stations are processed through the central server using a single telephone connection for both speed and economy.

Cashier terminals can be used at the exit lane, in a central cashiering mode, in valet applications and in a stand-alone environment.

The machine readable cashier terminal is part of a complete on-line, real-time system that includes machine readable ticket dispensers, ticket readers, on-line validators, pay-on-foot stations, and integrated access, debit, and decrementing cards. All Secom systems are tailored to meet specific client requirements.

Ergonomically designed for speed and ease of operation, the on-line, real-time machine readable cashier terminal:

- ***Includes eight concurrent programmable rate structures;***
- ***Has hundreds of validation possibilities;***
- ***Integrated credit card processing;***
- ***Calculates long & short term rates, valet and self-park, subsidized pre-purchased validations and charges to specific accounts.***

FEE CALCULATION METHODS

Fees are calculated based on the following methods, or a combination thereof, simultaneously:

- Elapsed time
- Specific Time of Day
- 24 hour anniversary of entry
- A rate day based on a start/stop time of day
- First day rates and subsequent day rates
- Special Events
- Flat Rate
- Entry time and/or exit time criteria
- Fee calculations for access cards as required by owner
- Nesting requirement or lack thereof
- Time Zone Violator rates and/or penalties.

RATES

The standard, expandable rates program provides for eight different rate schedules capable of all running concurrently and automatically applied without cashier action or decision. The rates programs include:

- Day rates
- Early bird rates
- Evening rates
- Night rates
- Weekend rates
- Holiday rates

Rates based on the day of the week

Rates that allow maximums for multi-day stays

Provide for prepaying charges to a dollar amount or to a time of day

The rates programs provide for user definitions that include the ability to define:

- Over 50 validation types
- The validation name (to be printed on receipts and/or tickets)
- A validation to be charged back to a merchant account
- A validation to be charged back to a merchant account at a different rate than the customer validation
- And process a lost ticket transaction
- And compute taxes by percent or fixed amount
- Apply or disallow a validation based on entry and/or exit time
- Control the mix-ability of validations
- Control the number of multiples of validations

Post validations or coupons

Apply or disallow validations based on elapsed time

The rates programs provide for validation types that include:

- 100 % Free
- First Day Free
- Free days
- Free billing increments
- Money off
- Time off
- Limit daily maximum
- Flat Rate
- One time surcharge
- Daily surcharge

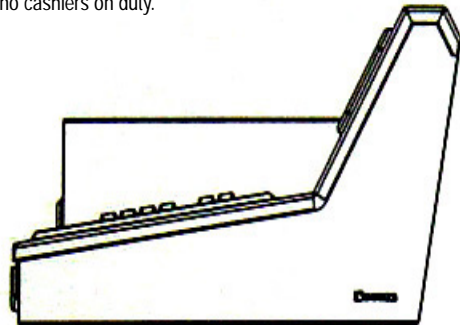
The rates programs provide for the following user definable grace periods:

- Turnaround – to permit a driver to quickly exit if choosing not to park
- Continuous – to allow for possible rush hour time spent in exit queue
- Delayed – to permit parker to pay at central location, return to vehicle and proceed to exit lane

The rates programs provides for the ability to:

- Validate an unknown ticket at a register and at an on-line validator;
- Assign a validation to an unknown ticket at a Pay on Foot device.

The rate programs provide for free exits during user defined times when there may be no cashiers on duty.
