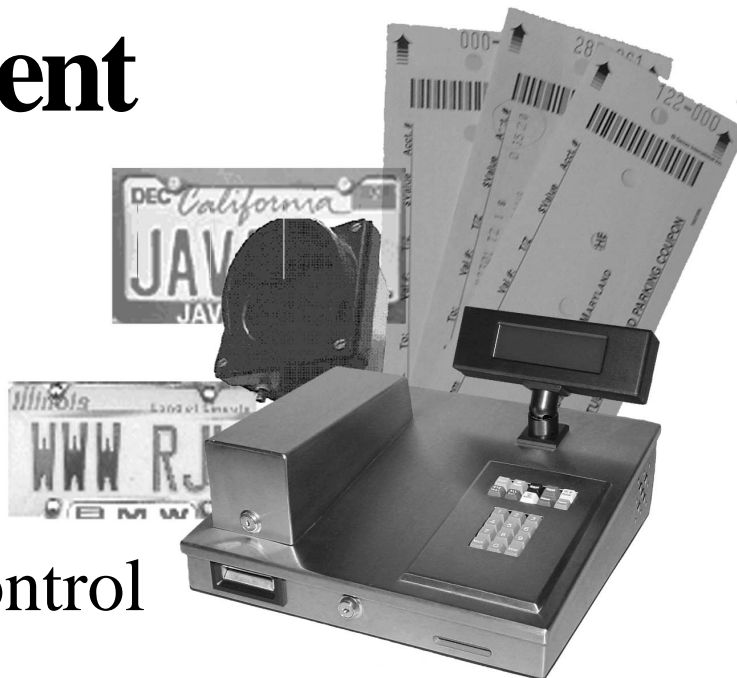

How It Works:

After a customer has completed the necessary paperwork the rental associate will enter the vehicle license plate number into the terminal and 'link' a machine readable ticket. The system will print the license plate information, date and time on the ticket and remember this information at the central processor. The attendant hands the ticket to the client and instructs the client to insert the ticket in the ticket acceptor on exit.

The post-mounted camera in the exit lane will read the license plate and match the time, day and license plate information to the ticket the client inserts in the ticket acceptor and causes the gate to open if all the information matches up correctly. If the information does not match the gate remains closed and an alarm is sounded at the system terminal.

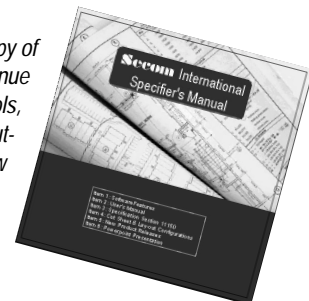
