Ticket Dispenser or Cashier Terminal?

Secom provides the most efficient and rugged method of revenue collection for an event. Here's how it works: First, the system administrator invokes the "Prepay" mode at the admin station. Then, when a vehicle pulls into the lane, the attendant collects the fees and presents his previously assigned prepay attendant card to the card reader causing the prepay ticket to be issued with the word "PREPAY" printed on it. The gate vends when the ticket is taken. Both the prepay validation and the prepay dollar amount are posted to the ticket on the ticket file.

When the ticket is processed at a register or ticket acceptor, the system calculates the charges due and applies prepaid amount. If no money is due, the parker may exit. If there is money due, which is typically the result of the parker remaining in the facility longer than the prepay validation was defined to cover, the amount due will be displayed on the register or at the ticket acceptor.

There may be parkers who use the facility for parking to shop and are not attending the event, they can simply push the button, receive a ticket, park, and pay the standard transient rates upon exiting.

Note -

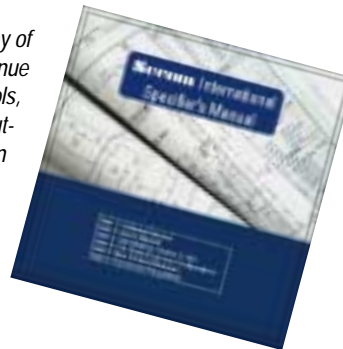
Any Secom system equipment can be upgraded to the 030 Server System and necessary peripheral devices to support the Auto Cashier.

Any other brand of equipment will need to have the controller, and ticket dispensers changed to Secom to support machine readable barcode tickets. Existing card system (contact factory for compatible systems), intercom system and gates may still be utilized.
