Introducing the latest revenue management tool: Marge! Marge consists of several programs that accumulate revenue data for subsequent reporting. These on demand reports can be generated to reflect totals on a daily, weekly, monthly, and yearly basis —as well as last week, last month, and last year.

The files in which the data is accumulated and stored are protected. The user cannot alter or delete the data. Further, the data cannot be copied (restored to the hard drive) from a backup medium, maintaining data integrity and eliminating the possibility of tampering with the numbers. The hard drive can be sealed to detect physical tampering with the fixed disk drive itself, as mandated by municipal regulations, and only certified personnel are authorized to break the seal.

The Daily Revenue Report, a week-to-date report prints automatically.

- Year to Date by Device or LTN
- Daily (week-to-date) Totals
- Last Week Totals
- Month to Date Totals

MARGE accumulates data on a daily basis by employee, device, and the Daily total (for all ltms and employees). The daily data is accumulated in a separate record for each day of the year. Each night, the system automatically "closes out" the daily records and begins accumulating data in the next days' records. The daily records are closed out at the times indicated below. While these times are hard-coded, they can be changed to fit your requirements. The capacity of the Marge files is 25 years, beginning with January 1, 2001.

The Marge reports contain data with respect to Total Charges, Cash, Unpaid, Parker Charges and Account Charges, the number of Transactions and their type (barcode, manual, random digit, and canceled transactions) as well as the number and value of validations and the number and value of the rate increment buckets.
